# **HC Andersen Building**

The HC Andersen school building was dedicated in 1910 and named after Hans Christian Andersen, famous Danish storyteller. In 1981 the original building was demolished and the current building erected. In 2004 the new East Central School opened near I-35, and the HC Andersen building was sold. In February 2012 the Pine County Historical Society acquired it, and we opened the doors in June of 2012. The café was named after one of HC Andersen's most famous stories, "The Little Mermaid."




## PINE COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY

Organized in 1948 by Pine County residents dedicated to preserving and protecting the history of the county, the Society today is supported by membership fees, legacies, donations, and an appropriation from the county.
